 - the block diagram
 - the description of the implementation flow
 - the description of the functionalities from all implemented modules
 - the description of the implemented algorithms
 - the description of the application usage

4. Experimental results

- the practical results obtained in different test cases (scenarios)
- the remarks on each obtain result
- the proof that the obtained results are valid

5. Conclusions

- the achievements and the way of accomplishing the objectives
- the personal contributions
- the observations about the obtained results
- the future development directions
